This hybridized chile of *Capsicum chinense* and *frutescen* varieties is known by many names {*Bih Jolokia*, ?Bih? meaning ?poison in Assamese?; *Naga Mirchi* or King Cobra Chilli; *Naga Jolokia*, named after the fierce headhunter warriors in Nagaland; *Naga Morich*; *etc.*} and for many years was merely an unsubstantiated ?myth? as the chiles never left the off-limit Northeastern Indian states of Assam, Manipur, and Nagaland, the warring tribal area next to Myanmar (Burma); above Bangladesh and beneath Bhutan (*possibly* where ?bhut? derived).
